2021年1月14日

今日はすべて日本からの観測となった。そのため、Mare Cimmerium から Mare Sirenum までの様子しかわからなかった。SPCの見えにくい方向で、ほとんどきろくできていない。井上, 伊藤がかすかに記録できているだけになった。B画像を見ていくと、北半球が明るく、水蒸気が集まっているように見える。南半球は南極地域を取り巻く雲と、南緯 50° 付近に見える雲（東西方向）が今日も見える。ただし 50° 付近の雲はかなり淡い。

All observations were from Japan today. Therefore, I could only understand the situation from Mare Cimmerium to Mare Sirenum. The SPC is difficult to see, and it is hardly clear. Inoue and Ito were only able to record faintly. Looking at the B image, the northern hemisphere is bright and it looks like water vapor is gathering. In the Southern Hemisphere, clouds surrounding the Antarctic region and clouds visible near 50° S (east-west direction) can still be seen today. However, the clouds around 50° are quite faint.
