Stanislas Maksymowicz は Thaumasia Foelix (70W~105W,-30~-43)から Mare Sirenum (140W~170W,-30)にかけて雲の帯を記録している。この時期、南極を取り巻く地域には白雲が見えることが多いが、ベルト状の白雲の時期は少し過ぎている。位置的にはやや低緯度に近く、ほかの観測者の情報に注意したい。Shigeru Kurisu は模様の鮮明な画像を報告してきた。これを見ると、模様には変化はない。濃さは実際よりもかなりコントラストがついている。Noachis (335W~10W,-25~-30)の東部はかなりダスティーに見える。

Stanislas Maksymowicz records a cloud band from Thaumasia Foelix (70W \sim 105W, -30 \sim -43) to Mare Sirenum (140W \sim 170W, -30). White clouds are often visible in the area surrounding Antarctica during this period, but the belt-shaped white clouds have passed a little. The position of the clouds is a little close to the low latitude, so I would like to pay attention to the information of other observers. Shigeru Kurisu has reported a clear image of the pattern. Looking at this, there is no change in the pattern. The darkness is much more contrasting than it really is. The eastern part of Noachis (335W \sim 10W, -25 \sim -30) looks pretty dusty.
