Brown letters are the description about dust.

Mark Lonsdale の画像には NPC が写っていない。8月3日の後半がダストストームだとすると、3日後の今日は、拡散して、NPC が見えにくくなっていても不思議ではない。これ以上の情報はなく、はっきりしないのが残念だ。Clyde Foster は7月末に盛んに観測された、Tharsis ($80W\sim120W,+10$)付近の観測を報告してきた。Tharsis ($80W\sim120W,+10$)の山と Olympus Mons (135W,+25)との間の白雲の姿を見事にとらえている。画僧は、白雲のある所とないところが、色の違いで見事に記録されている。また、この画像には南極雲が淡く記録されている。

The NPC is not visible in Mark Lonsdale's image. If the dust storm occurred in the latter half of August 3rd, it would not be surprising if it had diffused and become difficult to see three days later. Unfortunately, there is no further information available and the situation remains unclear. Clyde Foster reported observations of the area near Tharsis (80W~120W, +10), which was heavily observed at the end of July. He beautifully captured the white clouds between the mountain Tharsis (80W~120W, +10) and Olympus Mons (135W, +25). The artist beautifully recorded the difference in color between the areas with and without white clouds. The image also faintly records the sph. clouds.
