伊藤から報告を受けた。画像を見る限り、NPC が不明瞭に見える。おそらくダストに覆われているためだろう。Syrtis Major $(293W,+0\sim20)$ の写り方を見ると、Sinus Sabaeus $(320W\sim350W,-10)$ がもっと見えやすくなっていないといけないが、この付近もダスティーなのだろう。Hellas $(275\sim315W,-30\sim60)$ は霜のようで、白く明るく記録された。

I received a report from Ito. Looking at the image, the NPC appears unclear, probably due to dust covering it. Judging from the way Syrtis Major (293W, $+0\sim20$) is captured, Sinus Sabaeus (320W ~350 W, -10) should be more visible, but this area is probably also dusty. Hellas (275 ~315 W, $-30\sim60$) looks like frost, and was recorded as a bright white.
