Looking at the image of Ito's Stack only, the area around Arabia ($310W \sim 330W \sim +35 \sim +10$) is reddish. I had a terribly bad seeing, but he set a record because the SPR didn't look bright at all. Ito's image recorded the appearance without white clouds in the SPR, and it turned out that the appearance I saw was correct. Dmitry W. von Aichegg recorded the west side of Solis Lacus being vaguely black and returning to its original form.
