今日は二人の眼視観測者から報告を受けた。二人とも Solis Lacus が見える経度の観測である。Chris Nuttall は Chryse 付近を明るく記録している。Paul G. Abel は Mare Sirenum 南方の雲が肉眼でも健在である様子を記録している。視直径は6秒よりも小さくなったが、シーイングや倍率など、条件がよければ、まだ観測は可能である。

I received reports from two visual observers today. Both are observations of longitude where Solis Lacus can be seen. Chris Nuttall records brightly around Chryse. Paul G. Abel records that the clouds south of Mare Sirenum are still alive with the naked eye. The apparent diameter has become smaller than 6 seconds, but observation is still possible under good conditions such as seeing and magnification.
