
2022, Feb. 03 Two dust storms in the north of Hellas



Clyde Foster discovered

The dust storm on the west side (south south) occurred on February 2, the day before, and a small light spot was recorded. (Center of the photo) The dust storm on the west side (right side) occurred one day later, and a slightly wide and bright figure was recorded on February 3. On February 1st, Hellas is a dark dusty, but the light spots of the dust storm are not yet visible. There are observations in the same area, but they have not yet occurred at that time.

- Feb. 1 Dusty, but no dust storm.
- Feb. 2 A small dust storm occurs south of Hellas. (Red arrow)
- Feb. 3 A small dust storm occurs southwest of Hellas. (Yellow arrow)

 It invades Yaonis R. (315W, -33) to the west from the northwestern part of Hellas.
