Syrtis Major (293W,+0~20)は、Clyde foster の画像では北の端まで、全体が記録されている。北端の形は今まで、写りにくかったが、今日は全体が写っている。G 画像は、Hellas 以南が明るく、この緯度より南側はダスティーな様子が記録されている。眞島の観測では Arsia Silva Mons (W120,-3)の雲が良く見える。

Syrtis Major (293W, $+0\sim20$) is recorded in its entirety all the way to the northern end in the Clyde Foster image. Until now, the shape of the northern end was difficult to see, but today the whole thing was visible. The G image shows that the area south of Hellas is bright, and that areas south of this latitude are dusty. Mashima's observations show the clouds of Arsia Silva Mons (W120, -3) clearly.
