

Black letters are mainly descriptions of patterns.

Blue letters are descriptions of polar caps and clouds.

Brown letters are the description about dust.

John Sussenbach の画像は、Sinus Sabaeus (320W~350W,-10)から Meridian (0W,-5)の形がノーマルな姿ではない。この付近にダストがあるため、通常の模様が見えにくくなっているためである。色合いを見ると、ダストの範囲が黄色っぽく見えるように思うが、果たして本当の位置や濃さに近いのかはわからない。

In the image by John Sussenbach, the shape of Sinus Sabaeus (320W~350W,-10) to Meridian (0W,-5) is not normal. This is because the dust in this area makes the normal pattern difficult to see. Looking at the color, the dust area seems to look yellowish, but I don't know if that's close to the actual position and density.
