Black letters are mainly descriptions of patterns.

Blue letters are descriptions of polar caps and clouds.

Brown letters are the description about dust.

Red is a special note.

2024年10月07日 (2024, Oct. 07)

眞島の画像は、Olympus Mons (135W,+25)がはっきりせず、色も赤黒くない。一方、北半球の北緯 50° 付近には赤黒い斑点が記録されている。これは Alba (115W.+45)である。それほど高い山ではないが、赤黒く記録されているところを見ると、この付近のダストは淡くなっていると思われる。南半球では Mare Sirenum (140W~170W,-30)の東側が見ていない。この部分は濃いダストが覆っているように見える。

In the Majima image, Olympus Mons (135W, +25) is not clear, and it is not reddish-black in color. On the other hand, a reddish-black spot is recorded near 50° north latitude in the Northern Hemisphere. This is Alba (115W, +45). It is not a very high mountain, but the fact that it is recorded as reddish-black suggests that the dust in this area is faint. In the Southern Hemisphere, the eastern side of Mare Sirenum (140W~170W, -30) is not visible. This area appears to be covered with thick dust.
