Mike Karakas と Frank J Melillo の観測からは、Solis Lacus (W90;-28)に雲がかかり、黒く見えなくなったことが分かる。また、Chryse (35W,+10)付近が明るかった様子も落ち着いてきた。火星面は、最接近になり、東と西のリムに白雲がほとんど均等に見えている。火星観測は折り返し点になった。

Mike Karakas and Frank J Melillo's observations show that Solis Lacus (W90;-28) is covered with clouds and no longer looks black. Also, the bright area around Chryse (35W,+10) has calmed down. The Martian surface is at its closest point, and white clouds are almost evenly visible on the eastern and western limbs. Mars observations have reached the halfway point.
